Mother of Divine Grace School reserves the right at anytime to amend or add to the policies, rules and regulations contained in the lunch program rules, and to make such changes applicable to current and new students when the situation dictates.

- *Students must listen to and respect all lunch parents and other students.
- *Students must wait in their seats to be called up to get his/her hot lunch.
- *Students who do not order hot lunch will not and may not get hot lunch.
- *No child may bring in a lunch that needs to be heated in the microwave.
- *All students are responsible for cleaning up after themselves.
- *Students are not permitted to use the bathrooms in the church hall unless it is an emergency. The students are given time to use the bathrooms after lunch in the school building.
- *Students may not get out of their seats without first asking.
- *Students must wait to throw out their trash table by table.
- *Students may not throw food, napkins, etc. at anyone or anything.
- *In side voices must be used at all times.
- *Everyone must keep their hands, arms, feet and legs to themselves.
- *Students must wait for a lunch parent to go out side.
- *There is no running, pushing or screaming in the school yard.
- *There is no ball playing or jumping rope in the school yard.
